Our local **Worcestershire Breast Unit** campaign; each bras in the bras chain will be sponsored. The **Women's Aid** organisation will receive all the new bras. You will appreciate women who leave home in a hurry to escape danger the last thing they think of is undies. **Breakthrough Breast Cancer** the charity which will receive all funds from bras which are past their best and have to be recycled.

However you get them, it will be great to show our support a local campaign - and let's be ready at St Mary's for the 31 July at Worcester Racecourse when the Guinness Book of Records longest bras chain record will hopefully be broken.

Record so far:

In Bundaberg, Australia on 9th August 2009 the length was 163.77 km that's 166,625 bras in the chain.
